Heiko,

I followed your lead and got my irons reshafted, tried out Precision but settled on Nippon NS 950, it's actually helped me square the clubhead with the longer irons. PW to 6i probably 15 yards longer and the slight fade has gone.

5,4,3i much straighter also.

The handicap is coming down, I'm playing off 5 now, the release is getting smoother. So I learned quite a lot in Hamburg, you found the faults with my technique and now I have found an excellent clubmaker who is helping me work around my physical limitations while I continue to work on technique.

An easy 8i now flies ~151yds (20°C titleist prov1) and my technique is much simpler than it was. I've gained distance and that has allowed me to throttle back and hit all my irons in quite a controlled way. With the new shafts the long irons are much much easier to hit and my distance control is much much better, with the short irons I'm trying to knock it close every time now.

Its strange, I came to hamburg to hit driver like Austin, but ended up improving my irons!!

I'm sure I'm going to be scratch soon.

I'll let you know when I get there
